CAMP RULES



When attending Wing, Squadron or annual camps the following rules must be observed.

1. Stealing and bullying will not be tolerated. The offenders' parents/guardians will be informed and requested to collect you forthwith. In cases involving theft the police will be informed.
2. All cadets should read and keep any written joining and travel instructions.
3. Kit lists are used as a guide. Equipment must be in serviceable condition and fit for the purpose. Boots should be of the correct size.
4. Parents/Guardians should make appropriate arrangements for their children to be met or picked up after camp.
5. Cadets will, of their own initiative or when told, call their parents when nearing drop off point.
6. No expensive electrical items should be taken to camp. Neither the staff nor Air Cadet Organisation can be held responsible for lost or stolen valuables.
7. No cadet from this squadron will be allowed to smoke. If you do smoke and are not willing to adhere to this rule please do not enter your name for consideration.
8. Remember that the organising staff go to a lot of trouble to make camp as enjoyable as possible for everyone (Yes, even themselves!). If you do not like an activity do not start moaning about it, other cadets may not like the activity you like, just join in and don't spoil it for everyone else.
9. Lights out means **LIGHTS OUT!**
10. When on camp you may be given a temporary rank, this is exactly what it says it is.
11. Personal hygiene is vital when on camp. You are living with strangers. You would not like to spend your camp with someone who has a hygiene problem, well neither do they!
12. Male and female dormitories (inc. tents) are out of bounds to members of the opposite sex.
13. Please enjoy yourselves but be aware that horseplay can quickly deteriorate into trouble.
